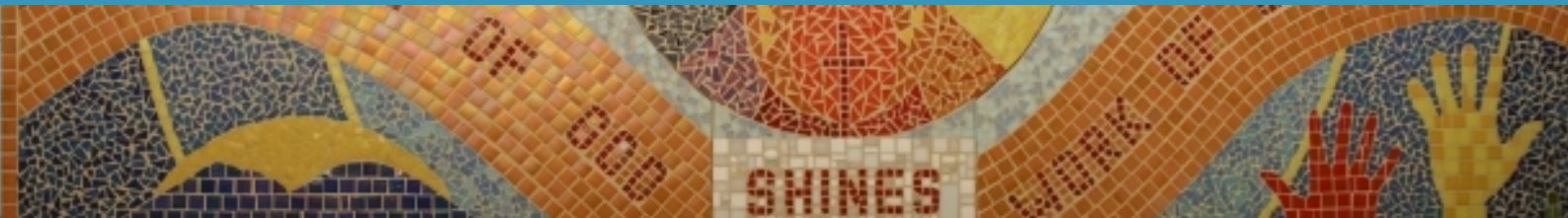

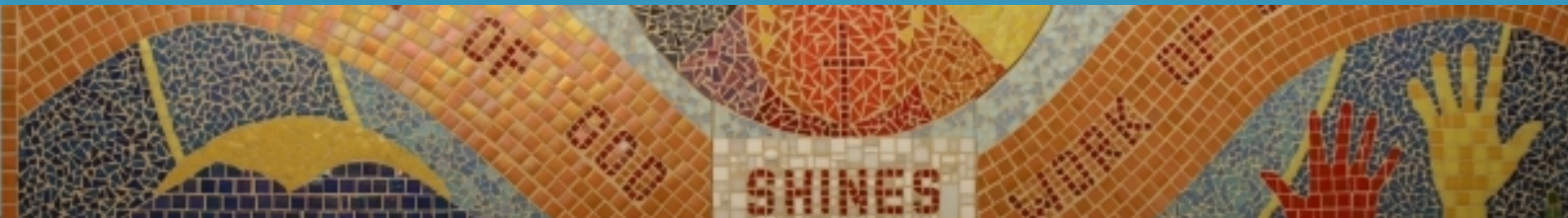
## UNIFORM REMINDERS

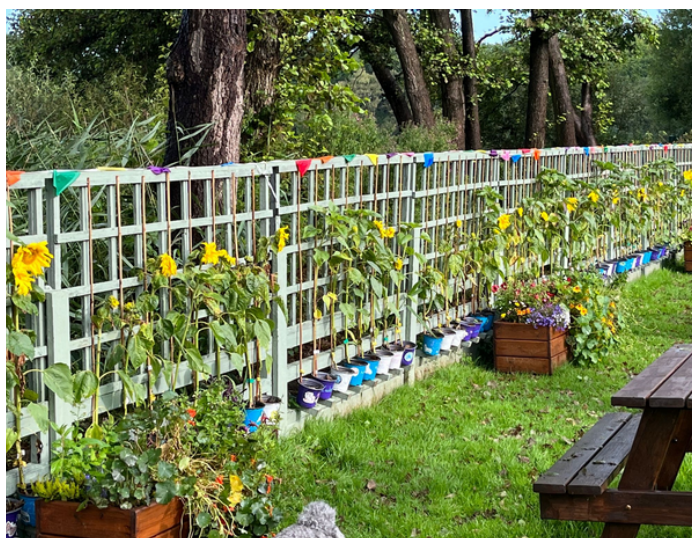
## SCHOOL MEALS

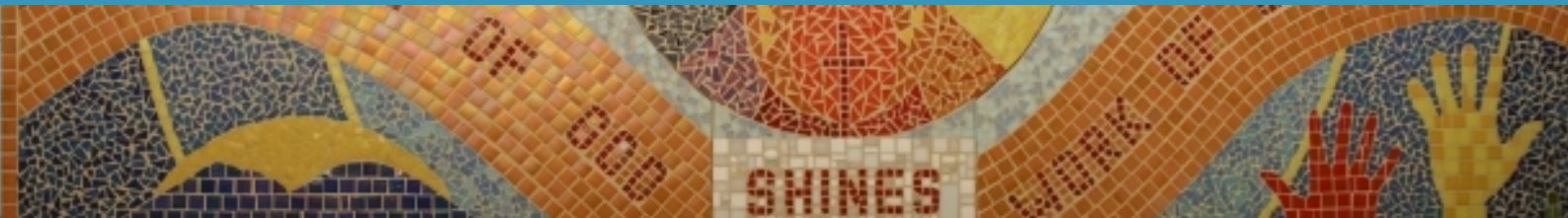
