PARENT PAY



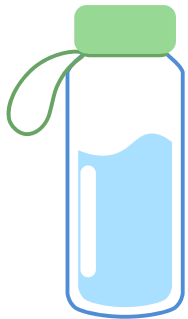
Thank you to those parents/carers who have already paid outstanding balances on Parent Pay.

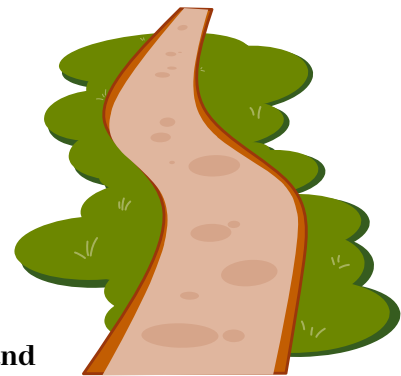


WATER

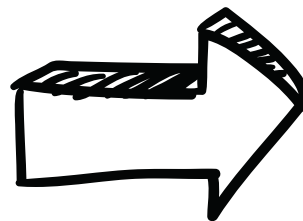
HEALTH AND SAFETY
