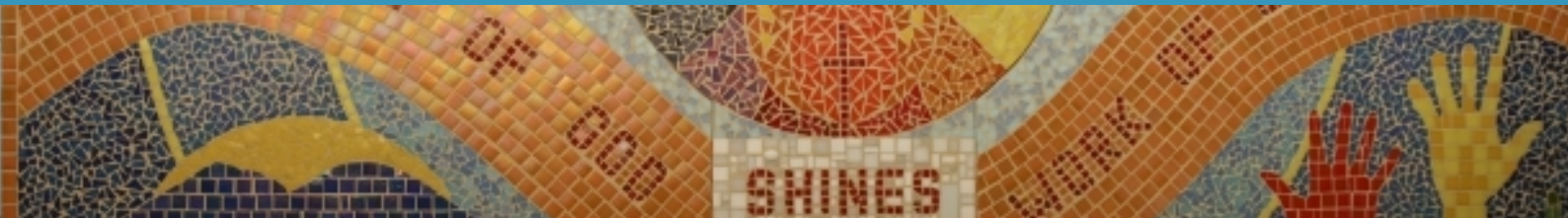

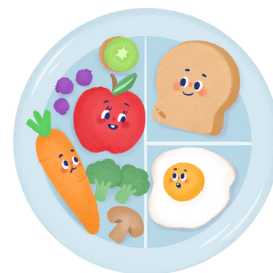


## LEAVERS SERVICE

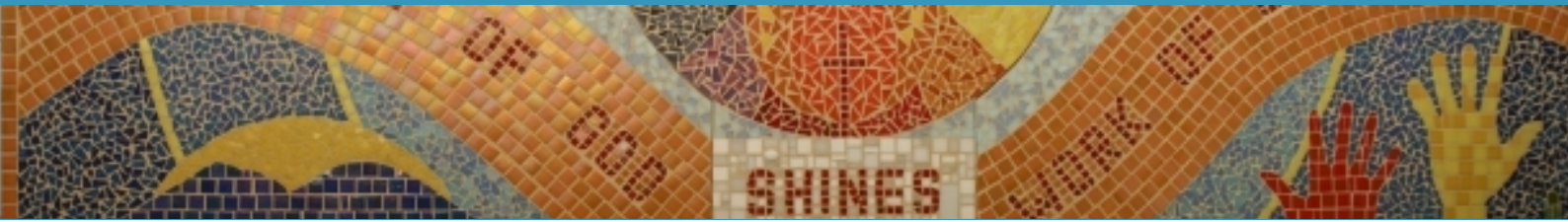
## STRONGER STARTS AT TESCO
