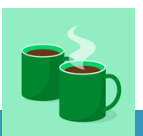
MACMILLAN COFFEE MORNING

Donations of tea, coffee and cake will be greatly appreciated. Please leave these at the school office no later than Thursday 26th September.

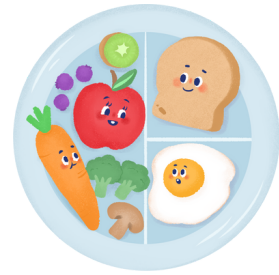
Hopefully together, we can raise plenty of money for this amazing charity. Thank you for your support!
