## CLASS 2

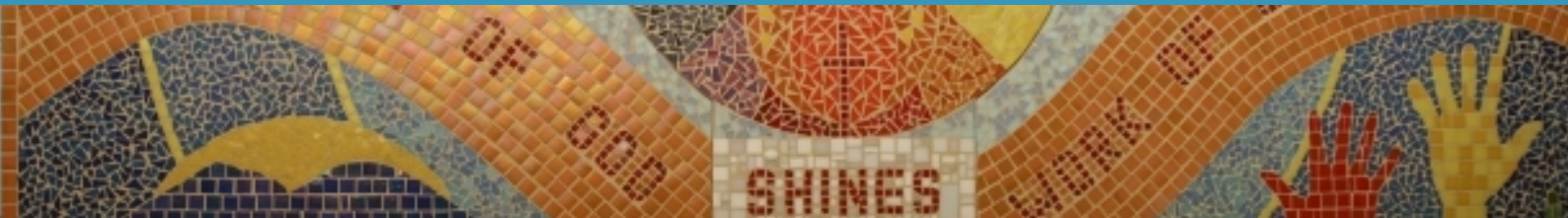


It's been a busy week for class 2 who came into class and found a postcard sent from London. The postcard had a secret recipe inside it for bread which they made and toasted on a campfire.
