The week starting 23rd September will be week 1 of school dinners and the menu can be found on our website. The school meal price has increased to £2.99 per day

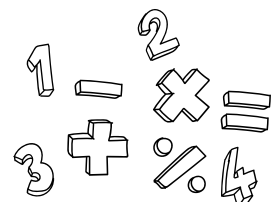
and break-time snack is 30p per day.

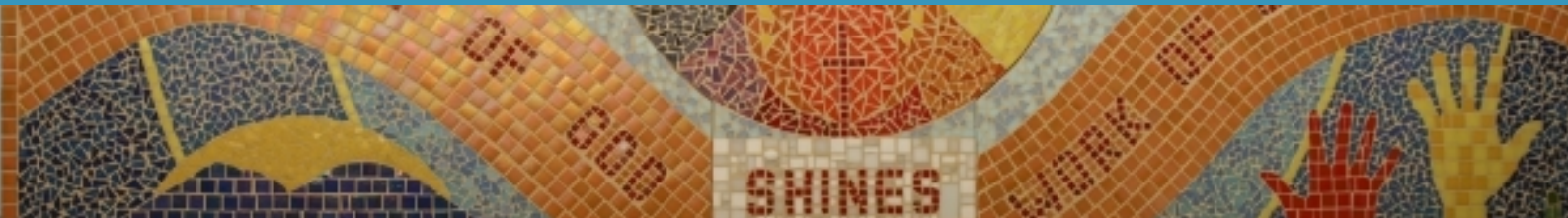
