Please can we remind you of our uniform policy which is on our website under 'policies'.

- Plain pale blue polo shirt with or without school logo
- Plain pale blue sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo
- Plain grey skirt, pinafore dress, trousers or shorts
- Plain grey tights or socks
- or the above may be replaced by a light blue gingham check dress (not playsuit) worn with white socks
- Black shoes, leather or leather look (not canvas or suede or any kind of boot)
- Plain outdoor coat (with or without school logo)
- Plain, unbranded sun hat/cap (with or without school logo) PE Kit
- Plain navy sports shorts plain white t-shirt (with or without school logo)
- Black pumps or suitable outdoor trainers
- Plain navy hoodie (with or without school logo) is optional
- Plain navy jogging pants (with or without school logo) are optional
- No nail varnish

NB: A Year 6 child may wear their 'leaver's hoodie' during PE lessons and as an outside coat in milder weather
